The BRICS Energy Report is the first study prepared by experts of the BRICS Energy Research Cooperation Platform. The five countries will present their vision as BRICS on the global energy landscape that is based on their own statistical data and internal forecast estimates. At the same time, the decisions made in BRICS states will be of increasing importance for the future of energy industry.
