Technological cooperation is one of the priorities of BRICS energy agenda. In 2020, as a first step towards it, the BRICS Energy Research Cooperation Platform conducted a survey among fuel and energy companies, relevant ministries and research institutes with a purpose to identify the technological needs and mutual interests of the five countries in the oil and gas, coal and electricity fields.

Based on the responses received, the experts of the Energy Platform formed a final report, including conclusions about the interests of each of the countries, and a list of mutual interests in the development of energy technologies. Representatives from over 60 BRICS fuel and energy companies, energy institutions and individual experts took part in the survey.
